# VILLAGE OF AVONLEA

#### **BYLAW No.270-17**

A Bylaw to Regulate the Collection and Disposal of Refuse within the Village of Avonlea.

The Council of the Village of Avonlea, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- The Village will provide for the collection, removal and disposal of refuse at least twice weekly in all
  commercial and industrial zones within the Village of Avonlea.
- The Village will contract curbside pickup services of Lorans Disposal for the biweekly collection, removal and disposal of refuse and recycling for residential zones within the Village of Avonlea.
- No person shall set, feed or maintain, or cause to be set, fed or maintained an open fire for the disposal of any refuse within the Village of Avonlea.
- 4. The Village will designate areas at the landfill for the disposal of Compost, Metals, Trees, Wood.
- 5. The Village landfill is maintained for the disposal of refuse generated within the Village limits.
- The Village landfill will be maintained by a gate attendant. Everyone entering the landfill must report their name and materials to the attendant. Verbal abuse or improper dumping will result in the ratepayer's landfill privilege being revoked.
- 7. The village landfill will not allow the dumping of electronics, paint cans, tires, batteries, propane tanks, chemical containers, hazardous waste, toxic waste of any kind, explosives, animal carcasses, oil and oil filters, cardboard, paper, tin cans, plastic, shingles, concrete, drywall, siding, windows, doors and painted wood.
- The Village Landfill's hours of operation are prescribed in Appendix A and shall be fixed from time to time by resolution of council.

9. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect when adopted by council.
